Music : Ain't What It Used To Be by Billy Currington (118 bpm)

**Beginning of the dance** : *on the vocals*

Counts	Step Description	Instructions	Direction
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Start position : hands on the wheels

Section 1	Roll Forward – Full Turn Right		
1 – 3	Roll forward	Roll	Forward
4 – 8	Make a full turn to the right (12 :00)	Full Turn	Right

Section 2	Roll Forward – ½ Turn Left – Roll Forward – ¼ Turn Left		
1 – 4	Roll Forward	Roll	Forward
5 – 6	½ turn to the left (6 :00)	½ turn	Left
7	Roll Forward	Roll	Forward
8	¼ turn to the left (3 :00)	¼ turn	Left

Section 3	Right Pivot – ¼ Turn Left – Left Pivot – Roll Backward		
1 – 2	Make a chair pivot to the left (1 :30)	Pivot	Left
3 – 4	¼ turn on the right (4 :30)	¼ turn	Right
5 – 6	3/8 turn to the left (12 :00)	3/8 turn	Left
7 – 8	Roll slowly backward	Roll	Backward

Section 4	Roll Forward – ½ Turn Left – Hold – Wheels Stomp		
1 – 4	Roll forward	Roll	Forward
5 – 6	Make a ½ turn to the left (6 :00)	½ turn	Left
7	Hold	Hold	On the spot
8	Tap at the same time on the wheel with the hands	Stomp	On the spot
